LESSON OBJECTIVE:

- To **UNDERSTAND** THE WORK OF EMMANUEL JAL
- To **THINK ABOUT** PEACEFUL SOLUTIONS TO LIFE'S DIFFICULTIES AND HOW YOU TO TAKE PART IN THE LOSE TO WIN CHALLENGE TO HELP OTHERS.



LESSON OUTCOMES:

TO CREATE A PLATFORM TO DISCUSS HOW EDUCATION CAN PLAY A PART IN BRINGING PEACE TO INDIVIDUALS, COMMUNITIES AND MAINTAINING PEACEFUL SOLUTIONS FOR THE LONG-TERM.



STARTER

STUDENTS ARE GIVEN STATEMENTS AND ASKED TO POSITION THEMSELVES IN A LINE WITH ONE SIDE BEING 'STRONGLY AGREE' AND ONE SIDE BEING 'STRONGLY DISAGREE'.

IDEAS FOR STATEMENTS (RECAPPING PRIOR LEARNING)

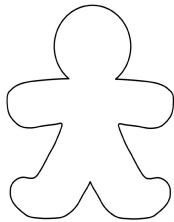
- CHILD SOLDIERS ARE USUALLY BOYS AND THEY ARE USUALLY FORCED TO TAKE UP ARMS
- MIGRATION USUALLY LEADS TO A BETTER LIFE FOR THOSE WHO MIGRATE
- IF YOU WERE MIGRATING YOU BE HELPING YOUR FAMILY

Learning Outcomes: students recap prior learning and understand that these issues are not black and white, but that there are many different ways children become 'child soldiers' and many different reasons for which people migrate.

AS STUDENTS ARE WATCHING THEY SHOULD BE THINKING ABOUT THE ISSUES OF CAUSE AND EFFECT. STUDENTS SHOULD JOT DOWN ANYTHING THEY HEAR ABOUT WHAT HAPPENED TO EMMANUEL AS A CHILD INSIDE THE GINGER BREAD MAN AND ANYTHING THEY HEAR ABOUT HIS DECISIONS AS AN ADULT OUTSIDE THE GINGER BREAD MAN.

Learning Outcomes: students learn about the issues of cause and effect. Students create a visual representation of what Emmanuel Jal has dealt with and achieved in his life.
